

We have resumed riding lessons with the CDC's restrictions and guidelines for social distancing in mind

- Private lessons (65.00 per hour)
- Monthly group lessons are now limited to 3 people per time slot (200 or 250 depending on the month)
- Drop in lessons and/or semi private lessons (2 people) are 55.00 per person
- Riders committing to the full month will receive priority over drop in lessons

## **NEW CONDITIONS: Please review the new policies carefully:**

1. Clients will meet their instructor in the arena
2. Instructors will prepare your horse for riding and return your horse to the barn and un-tack after the lesson is over
3. A \$10 tacking fee per lesson per person should be tipped to your instructor directly. Some instructors may have a cash app that you can use instead of cash
4. IF you need to come into the barn please wear a face covering and respect social distancing
  - \* Riders will be permitted to enter the barn to retrieve a helmet if there is not one outside on the picnic bench. Helmets are to be left with the instructor so that she may sanitize them before returning them to the tack room. Parents may help their child if they need help fitting and securing the helmet
5. Client and Instructor may drop face covering once they are outside and maintaining social distancing
6. Instructors will maintain at least a 6 foot distance at all times

## **Instructions for Registration**

Due to the high demand for lessons, reservations are accepted only with registration form and payment on a first come first serve basis. Please indicate a first or second choice on your registration form so that we may provide more options for you. Lesson registration forms may be scanned and sent via email or a picture may be emailed to the office at [wtr@worktoride.net](mailto:wtr@worktoride.net) . We will call or email to confirm your registration.

### **New Riders:**

**A completed registration form and payment is required to confirm registration.**

### **Continuing Riders:**

**To reserve your spot for the next month payment MUST be received by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month that you are riding. Due to the high demand we cannot hold a reservation with out confirmation.**

### **Payment Options**

You can make payments through PayPal ( [wtr@worktoride.net](mailto:wtr@worktoride.net) ), call the office to pay with credit card or drop a check in the mail ahead of time. We would like to reduce any need for contact. If using paypal please make a note to indicate registration information.

Our lesson availability remains the same as on the form: Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesday, Fridays & Saturdays.

We realize that grooming and tacking a horse is a major part of horsemanship and intrinsic to the riding experience but at this time we feel the safest option is for instructors to groom and tack. The upside to having your horse in the ring ready to go is that you will spend more time in the saddle!

### **Safety**

1. Instructors will wipe down all the equipment in between classes if a horse is used back to back, and after every lesson.
2. Riders are requested to wash their hands/sanitize before and after riding. We will have lots of soap available in the bathrooms.
3. The barn door and bathroom door is open to decrease handle touching.
