We teach English introductory riding. All lessons are 1 hour long; this includes grooming, tacking, mounting, tack adjustments, riding, cool down and dismounting.

Registration is allotted on a first come first served basis. Lesson scheduling is subject to availability.

Group Lessons ages 7+

Group Lessons are scheduled monthly riding once a week, at \$200 or \$250 depending on how many weeks are in the month. Lessons DO NOT roll over to the next month. In order to reserve your spots for the following month <u>confirmation (via text, email, call, or verbal)</u> <u>AND payment must be received no later than the 15th of the current month.</u>

There is **no credit given or make-up lesson** for lessons paid for but not attended.

Semi-Private and Private Lessons (By Appointment Only)

Private lessons: 1 rider(5 yr +) \$65.00 per lesson

*Children ages 5 & 6 are required to take private lessons for 1 on 1 instruction.

Semi- private lessons: 2 riders (7+) at \$55.00 per rider per lesson.

Policies:

- Payment in full is required to register
- **❖** To reserve your spot for the following month <u>confirmation</u> (via text, email, call, or verbal) <u>AND payment</u> must be received no later than the 15th of the current
 - > \$5.00 user fee on all credit card charges.
